## Participation Guidelines for *The First Tee of Birmingham* - 2006

*Thanks for signing up and being a part of our program!*

**This document must be read and signed by a parent or guardian of every First Tee participant. By signing and returning this agreement, you agree to and recognize the conditions of participation that are described below.**

The Facilities providing access to The First Tee of Birmingham are providing us with a great privilege and opportunity to utilize some of the best golf courses and practices areas in the Birmingham area. Therefore the following guidelines must be met at all times:

- 1. Participants will not be allowed to play on the golf course (9 or 18 holes) until they have been Par level certified or otherwise have authorization from both The First Tee and the golf course.**
- 2. Once participants have been certified to play, they will be allowed to make tee-times for Monday-Thursday. Friday-Sunday, tee times are allowed AFTER 3pm. These restrictions refer to access to the golf course itself, not the driving range. It is asked that you make a tee-time at least 24 hours in advance by phone. Please state that you are a The First Tee participant. Any tee-time allowed outside of these times is to be given at the sole discretion of the facility.**
- 3. A parent or guardian may play with a First Tee participant. Parents or guardians *will not* receive a discount when playing with a participant. If the parent or guardian wishes to purchase a cart they must pay full price for that cart. If the participant is going to walk and the parent is in a cart the participant must walk the entire round or pay for the rest of the cart. This will be charged at the discretion of the facility.**
- 4. Students who are not Par certified or do not have proper identification will not be allowed on the golf course without a parent or acceptable adult supervision.**
- 5. Students are required to make tee-times in advance. Tee-times and course access will be given to students at the discretion of the facility. Students **MUST** present their valid The First Tee identification at time of registration. If you do not have your identification you will be asked to pay full price. The facility will hold your The First Tee identification until your round is complete. Do not forget your identification at any facility.**
- 6. Students presenting their valid The First Tee identification are allowed to receive range balls for the driving range. Availability will be at the discretion of the facility. Buckets of balls are to be used by *The First Tee participants only*. Anyone else practicing with a The First Tee participant will be asked to purchase their own practice balls.**
- 7. Students are not allowed to be at the facility without a parent/guardian or responsible adult. Students must be picked up from the facility within 30 minutes of the programs end unless they have made a tee-time or prior arrangement and agreement with both**

the facility and with The First Tee organizer. Students are not to be in the golf shop of the facility unless they have a actual purpose for being there. Please plan to pick your student up from programming at a time stated, use of the facility phones is prohibited at anytime.

8. Anyone failing to follow these rules will have the following consequences.

1<sup>st</sup> offense- Verbal Warning

2<sup>nd</sup> offense- Written warning/ Meeting with parent/guardian

3<sup>rd</sup> offense- Loss of playing and practice privileges for one week

4<sup>th</sup> offense- Loss of playing and practice privileges for one month

5<sup>th</sup> offense- Removal from program
